More Information: This is a part-time program at BCIT which is recognized by the Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP). In a recent survey of 24 respondents who were recent graduates of the program, the average hourly wage was \$28, 88% were employed full-time, 75% stated that their job was very relevant to the material studied, 71% found work within 1-2 months of completing the program and 89% stated that the program was very useful in gaining employment.
